Examples of some projects we are or have been involved in:

ABCD

Blended learning demands new didactic concepts and methodologies for educationalists who deal with eLearning or blended learning arrangements. The course is supposed to enable stakeholders

of adult education to develop and realise combined training faster and more extensive and to some degree at a higher, comparable quality level.

ROSAE

Creation of European paper-based and e-learning training material on road safety with focus on three modules: Speeding and alcohol, Safety devices, as well as IT in vehicles.

PANDA

Creation of an B2B web platform that enables and makes it easier for organisations to find tenders and prepare tender applications with other organisations as well as address inefficiencies in the ERP/CRM value chain. This is done in a semi-automated fashion that interacts with among other organisation's ERP/CRM systems.

e-Pathways for Agriculturalists

Creation of European e-learning material for farmers to help them develop their activities. The project has among other a special focus on agro-tourism.
